1 LATA KINJANG WATERFALL

One of the tallest waterfalls in Asia. Located at Chenderiang. A long cascade on a forested hillside with a bridge offering close-up views and pools for swimming.



2 LATA ISKANDAR WATERFALL

Located at 14 km along the road to Cameron Highlands from Tapah Town. It is a dipterocarp forest with tall hard wood tropical trees. Shop for handycrafts and souvenirs made by the indigenous people here.

3 KG POS MUSOH CHALET

Located at Jalan Pahang Tapah, 25 km away from main road to the village. Initially this area was a battleground whereby the scene of a battle between the British government and the communists before independence and the battle of the Army with the Federal Police of Malaya (now known as Malaysia) against the communists until the communists laid down their arms on December 2, 1989. Therefore the area is known as Pos Musoh.





4 KUALA WOH FOREST PARK

The Kuala Woh Recreation Forest is located at Jalan Pahang which is 13 km from Tapah town and is easily accessible due to the perfect roads (amenities) available. Visitors should take the opportunity to enjoy the beautiful flora and fauna of this tropical garden.

5 ORANG ASLI CRAFT BAZAAR

Operated by Bah Dek a/l Bah Cheri, Bah Dek is an Orang Asli entrepreneur who runs an Orang Asli handicraft workshop located at Batu 5, Jalan Pahang, Tapah. There are various types of handicrafts that he produces and he receives many various orders for souvenirs, exhibitions and so on.



6 TAPAH STREET ART

Exhibit mural paintings such as the origins of Tapah town, Petai Lane, historic places and buildings, 3D paintings and so on.

7 WILDLIFE CONSERVATION CENTER

Wildlife Conservation Center, Sungkai is managed by the Perak Wildlife Department, with an area exceeding 50 hectares. The center began operations in 1971, the purpose of the establishment is to control and prevent the extinction of endangered animals. Apart from that this center is also a breeding center for endangered animals.



8 SUNGAI KLAH HOT SPRINGS

This place was built at a cost of RM6 million and was opened in December 2003. It is reputed to be one of the best managed hot spring in Malaysia and is located 200 feet above the sea level at the foothill of the Titiwangsa Range, the backbone range of Peninsular Malaysia.



9 SPECIAL BAMBOO RICE

The location is easy to find because it is only through the PLUS Highway exit to Sungkai, Trolak. Among the famous menus here such as hot fried catfish, fiber village chicken, black cooked meat, gulai kawah and the most popular is smoked meat.



10 NOORDIN FISH HEAD CURRY

Located on Jalan Besar Bidor, the special cuisine offered by Kandar Noordin Restaurant is well known among residents or visitors who pass through this small town. This is because the curry sauce used is said to be from a traditional spice blend which is a secret to its entrepreneurs. The fish heads offered are also of various types such as jenahak, keris, grouper and red. To ensure the supply of fish is always fresh, the operators make local from fisherman in Pantai Remis and Sungai Besar, Selangor or fisherman in Hutan Melintang and Teluk Intan in Perak.



PETAI BAZAAR 11

Visitors passing through the town of Bidor here will definitely not miss the opportunity to stop at the stalls on the sidewalk which has been famous for selling petai and local fruits for decades. Now, the sidewalk known as Lorong Petai by the local community has changed its face and name after being upgraded with the availability of more comfortable sales kiosks named, 'Petai Lane' as a result of the Tapah District Council initiative. If previously the stalls were only lined with newspapers and traders piled their sales on the street.

12 CHENDERANG BEST CAPATI

Capati Corner Tapah is located at Chenderiang Junction (Simpang Chenderiang). Capati Corner Tapah is open daily from 7 am to 7 pm. In addition to capati, there is a menu of rice, chicken and the latest Nan Cheese viral menu.



TAPAH ROAD RAILWAY STATION 13

This train station is one of the oldest in Malaysia. It opened on 18 May 1893, connecting Tapah Road with Teluk Intan and was inaugurated by the Governor of the Straits Settlements Sir Cecil Clementi Smith. Also present at the opening ceremony was Frank Swettenham, Perak Resident. At the initial stage of the Tapah Road-Teluk Intan railway construction contract, the planning was canceled due to terrain obstacles between the two places.

14 TEMOH LAKE

Recreation area, jogging with a nice view of the lake which is located at Temoh. The park was developed by the National Landscap Department under the Ministry of Urban Wellbeing, Housing and Local Government in collaboration with the Tapah District Council.



15 REFARM LEISURE PARK

26 acres recreational park which is surrounded by hills and forests, located 4km away from Kampar town. They produce organic fertilizer which recycled animals and plants' excrement through fermentation process.
